POSITION OVERVIEW:

The Intensive Family Support Worker acts as a vital component to the Joint Initiatives team within the Zero2Six Program. The Intensive Family Support Worker provides home-based family counselling, which assists families in addressing identified treatment goals, finding appropriate resources and provides crisis support as required. The Intensive Family Support Worker creates an environment where children, youth and their families can further their resilience and wellness and heal from the effects of trauma.

DUTIES/ RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide Client Services and Administer them in accordance with the guidelines of the Agency
- Provide family support to children (ages 0-6) and their families who are experiencing mental health difficulties
- Develop and implement individualized treatment plans in partnership with families, based on identified needs
- Provide home-based counselling, including parent education and coaching, skill teaching, and promoting positive parent-child relationships
- Assist families in finding appropriate resources and provide crisis support as required
- Liaise with client, family, school, and other service providers ensuring communication, continuity and support and other case coordination functions
- Work collaboratively with community partners to support the family's wellbeing
- Communicate openly and honestly with families, staff and supervisor
- Work autonomously within a multi-agency team context and in the community
- A flexible work schedule including evening hours is required
- A valid driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle is required

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

- Diploma or degree in Child and Youth Work or related discipline such as Social Work
- Membership within a professional association is preferred
- Minimum 3 to 5 years successful field experience, or a minimum of 5 years relevant education and special experience or skills
- First Aid Certificate, CPR (optional) and WHMIS (required) certifications

- Sound understanding of social learning and systems theories and an ability to apply them
- Experience and skills in engaging families to set and take action to reach mutually agreed upon goals
- Sound understanding of childhood and adolescent development and children's mental health
- Proven experience in a holistic treatment approach and applying wellness and resilience knowledge to therapeutic work
- Ability and desire to collaborate with the community and other services
- Excellent communication skills (both oral and written)
- Exceptional organizational skills and ability to work in an environment where juggling multiple demands and priorities is the norm
